Greetings to you all in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

It gives me immense Joy to be along with the members of the Abu Dhabi Mar Thoma Parish, in this season of abundant Joy and Hope through the Birth of Christ and as we enter with faith into the New Year 2018. May we all look back and thank God who has been faithful to us in our Life's journey along with Him. The famous quote that we read everywhere in this season of Joy is that "Jesus is the reason for the Season", in a way this is true. But we have to look into this more deeply, "Jesus became the reason for us

so that we can become the reason for Others". It means that you and me have to become His witnesses by sharing, loving, caring, forgiving the "Other" whom we have ostracized. This is Christmas, the bringing together of all creation to the Manger of Mysteries revealed to us. "Glory to God in the highest, peace on earth, good will to men, I bring you good news of great joy to everyone." These are the words the angels said over the hills outside of Bethlehem when they announced the birth of Jesus to the shepherds tending sheep through the night. It was great news. A baby had been born and this baby was the demonstration of God's love for us. That first Christmas is the reason we can live a life of purpose and significance. The baby in the manger was proof that God loved us, and that His love was deep enough to make a way for us to know Him. Experiencing a meaningful Christmas is not in buying more gifts or decorating more elaborately. It is in putting Christ first, focusing on what matters most, and then sharing that with others. What Jesus began as a baby in a manger, we get to continue. Jesus was about His Father's business during His life on the earth, and that is our mission as well! God? And how can we know it in this New Year that we are entering into. "Walk with the Lord" in His ways to know His will. "Invest in the Lord", give Him your everything and seek Him at all times. "Look to the Lord", at all times, for He will never fail you and finally, "Love as the Lord", show selfless love to all, pray for your enemies, smile at them and win their hearts. May the good Lord be with all of us in this New Year, may it be filled with the presence of God almighty and let our hearts be thirsty for God to do His Will revealed in the life of Christ. I once again thank and praise God for the Abu Dhabi Mar Thoma Church, for all your help, support and fellowship that each and everyone of you have been rendering towards the Utkal Mission and the various activities of the Delhi Diocese. 
